The character arcs backward in time from a woman profoundly devastated by betrayal and divorce to a fresh-faced, aspiring young actress in a hopeful new relationship. Seeking an engaging, intuitive, and versatile actress with excellent comic timing and a strong pop musical theatre mix from F3-D#5.

Jamie Wellerstein (male, mid-late 20s) – Jewish. Confident to the point of being cocky, with enough charm to still be likeable. The character arcs forward in time from an overly eager and endearing young man on a promising first date to a wildly popular author blinded by his own ambition, success, and ego. Seeking an engaging, commanding, and versatile actor with excellent comic timing and a strong pop musical theatre voice from A2-Bb4.
