Live To Tell by Eric Coble

Isabella (Female: Aged 16) Seeking a professional Hispanic/Latinx actress (age range 18–25) to portray a teenage girl. The character must be fluent in Spanish. She is soft-spoken yet strong-willed, with a calm presence and deep inner resolve. Driven by a quiet hope for something better, she is navigating the early steps of a personal transformation, grounded in courage and the desire to rise above her current life.

Alison (Female: Aged 16) Seeking a professional actress (age range 18–25) to portray a teenage girl. Open to performers of all ethnicities. The character is bold, outspoken, and unapologetically confident. She carries herself with attitude and charisma, never afraid to speak her mind or take up space.

Swagger by Eric Coble

Leela (Female: Aged 30s) Seeking a professional actor (age range 20–35) to portray a small business owner. Open to Hispanic, Latinx, and actors of all backgrounds. This character is sharp, witty, and driven. A confident and flirtatious woman with a quick sense of humor, she balances her ambition with the challenges of being a devoted mother of two. Strong presence and emotional range required.

Daniel (Male: Aged 30s) Seeking a professional actor (age range 20–35) to portray a police officer. Open to African-American and actors of all backgrounds. This character is sincere, kindhearted, and a bit socially awkward. He uses humor to connect with others and is always striving to do the right thing, even when it is not easy. A warm, relatable presence is key.

Jordan (Male: Aged 15) Seeking a professional actor (age range 18–25) to portray a teenage student. Open to actors of all races and ethnicities. This character is thoughtful, introspective, and quietly driven. He holds a strong sense of purpose and hope for the future while wrestling with questions of identity, ambition, and belonging as he searches for his place in the world.

Hungry Ghosts by Eric Coble

Valora (Female: 17) Seeking a professional actress (age range 18–25) to portray a teenage student. Open to actors of all races and ethnicities. This character is athletic, competitive, and driven by adrenaline. She thrives on movement, challenge, and the rush of taking risks. Strong physical presence and energy required.

Niri (Female: 14) Seeking a professional actor (age range 18–25) to portray a teenage student, Valora's younger sister. Open to actors of all races and ethnicities. This character is quiet, uncertain, and often overshadowed, but she carries deep emotional insight beneath the surface. Vulnerable yet perceptive, she is on the edge of finding her voice.

Kal (Male: 17) Seeking a professional actor (age range 18–25) to portray a teenage student. Open to Asian, Pacific Islander, and actors of all backgrounds. This character is a laid-back, creative soul who moves through school with an easygoing, almost weightless presence. A gifted musician, he drifts just outside the margins, observing more than he engages, with quiet depth behind his calm exterior.
