

Over-Hire Lighting Technician

Job Description:

The over-hire Lighting Technician (LT) is a part-time, seasonal, non-exempt position, which reports to the Head Electrician (HE). The LT is responsible for assisting with hang and focus calls and may include load-ins, strike, and any other typical duties associated with the position. This position does not guarantee specific work hours for any given week and calls may be solicited with short notice. Workers are given the right of refusal to any call.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities:

- Read and interpret lighting plots as designated by the HE
- Assist in installing and modifying lighting equipment

Qualifications & Requirements:

- Minimum of two years' professional experience hanging and focusing lighting equipment is preferred, but early career individuals will be considered
- Advanced understanding of lighting plots and paperwork
- Knowledge of intelligent lighting and DMX systems
- Knowledge of common lighting equipment such as ETC Source4 and ability to perform simple repairs
- Comfortable working at heights of >20 feet (grid height is ~24 feet)
- Ability to sit/stand for extended periods of time and bend, kneel and stoop while executing projects
- Ability to maneuver in the grid under and over I-beams; some positions are accessible with space to stand, and some require crawling or the use of automotive creepers
- Ability to multitask, prioritize, and meet deadlines in a fast-paced environment
- Ability to engage in positive, productive, and collaborative communications with team members and supervisors
- Flexible schedule for evening and weekend work calls
- Reliable transportation
- Ability to carry up to 50lbs alone and maneuver up to 120lbs with another staff member
- Ability to work on ladders and in Genie lifts
- Familiarity with safe and best practices for installing theatrical lighting
- Rigging experience is a plus
