This Pulitzer Prize-winning play tells the story of African-American brothers Lincoln and Booth, so named because their father thought it was funny. Spiritually wounded and barely scraping by, the brothers live in Booth's seedy boarding house room where they alternately support and disparage each other as they look back at their troubled past and look ahead to an uncertain future. A darkly comic trashtalking tale of simmering sibling rivalry.

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

New Year/New Plays Festival

The New Year/New Plays Festival, one of Palm Beach Dramaworks' most popular annual events, features readings of five intriguing plays that are still in development. The goal of the festival is to cultivate significant new work for PBD's mainstage and theatres across the country.

Drama(in the)works

Drama(in the)works is a free, virtual series of readings of evolving plays that involves the audience in the process of determining which works will be included in the next New Year/New Plays Festival. The readings take place on select Monday evenings and are followed by a talkback.

Dramawise

Dramawise is a multifaceted course for adults that provides insight into each of our mainstage plays and the creative process. The programs take place prior to the opening of each production, and include two acts and an intermission (lunch). Act I offers a comprehensive discussion about the play, and Act II features an intimate look at PBD's production with the director, actors, and designers. Participants may choose to attend all or a portion of the program.

Post-Performance Discussions

Talkbacks following Wednesday matinees and Sunday evening performances give audiences the opportunity to ask questions of the cast and delve deeper into the play and production.

Special performances and events that engage and inspire the LGBTQ community. Join us on the second Friday night of each of our mainstage productions. Evenings include a pre-show reception, the production, a post-performance talkback, and a post-show reception.
